



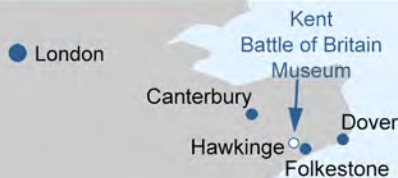



Visit the Kent Battle of Britain Museum on the site  
of RAF Hawkinge and walk in the footsteps of the

Get up close to the iconic Battle of Britain fighter  
planes - the Hurricane, Spitfire, Boulton-Paul  
Defiant, the Messerschmitt Bf109, Heinkel He III,  
Blenheim Mk IV and our latest addition the Junkers Ju 52.

Discover the stories of the brave airmen, the planes  
they flew, the uniforms they wore, the medals won  
and so much more - all in some of the original  
1940's buildings, still bearing the scars of war.
