

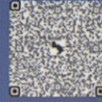

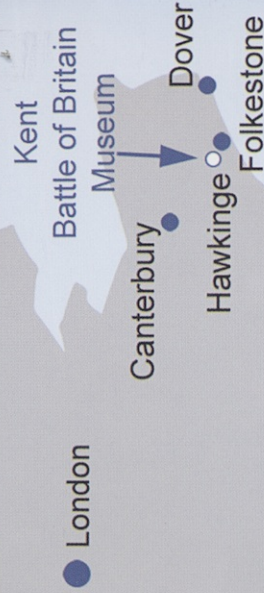

Visit the Kent Battle of Britain Museum on the site of RAF Hawkinge and walk in the footsteps of the greatest-ever air battle.

Get up close to the iconic Battle of Britain fighter planes - the Hurricane, Spitfire, Defiant, Whirlwind, Blenheim Mk IV, Messerschmitt Bf109, Heinkel He III, Junkers Ju 52 and our latest addition the Fieseler Fi 156 Storch.
